- 1. Kata: A sequence of movements students are learning in class (Taikyoku 1, Heian 1–5, Tekki, etc.)
- 2. Kumite: Partner work, includes combinations that students are practicing in class (5-step, 3-step, 1-step, Semifree) Adult brown and black belts: Jiyu kumite (brown belt eliminations), 2-minute Shobu Ippon match (all others)
- Team kata: A 3 student team performing synchronized kata (multi-age)
 Note: Only some competitors will be prepared for team katas. The three names on each team must be given before the
 February 18 deadline. If you do not have a team but are available for substitution, please let us know.

Fee: \$30 (Age 8–17) or \$40 (Age 18 or older) for 1, 2 or 3 events

Fee must be paid before February 18, 2017

Competitors: The competitors will be divided into three or more age categories for individual kata and kumite: 8–11 years, 12–17 years, adults 18 years and up.

There will be rank divisions (advanced white belts, yellow belts, orange, green, blue, purple, brown and black). A clean white uniform will be required for the competition day. Competitors should bring a snack, sweatshirt, socks and a water bottle. No glasses. No jewelry. Flat white hand protectors and mouth guard are required for all competitors doing Shobu Ippon kumite. Quiet in the gym please. No flash or video light in competitors' eyes please.
